**Circular:**

**Sub:** Finalization of fee structure of Master of Pharmacy Courses for the period from 2009-10 to 2010-11.

Sir,

The State Government has passed an Act No.2 of 2008 namely **“The Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007”** to make special provision for regulation of admission in the professional technical educational colleges or institutions in the State and fixation of fees in professional technical colleges or institutions and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

The act has come into force with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2008 vide Government of Gujarat, Education Department, Gandhinagar’s Notification No.GH/SH/5/08/PVS-10-2006-3185-S dated 30.4.2008.

As per the provisions laid down in the Act, Government has constituted a Fee Regulatory Committee for determination of fee structure for degree/diploma engineering/pharmacy/Architecture/Hotel & Tourism Management, MCA & MBA program in unaided professional colleges in the State. Subsequently, the Government of Gujarat vide notification number GH/SH/27/2008/PVS-10-2006-3185-S dated 18.11.2008 declared the Master of Engineering, Master of Technology, and Master of Pharmacy courses as the professional courses for the purpose of the Act.

The Committee, in its meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2009, decided to invite fee proposals for the year 2009-10 to 2010-2011 from all the concerned institutes for validation/determination of the fee structure by 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2009.

After considering the relevant provisions of the referred Act, the details submitted by the institutes and the actual cost for the year 2007-08 and/ or 2008-09 the committee has determined fee structure (the maximum ceiling limit) as per the **Annexure A**. The fee structure determined by the committee shall be applicable for the year 2009-10 and 2010-11. The fee structure so determined shall be applicable to a student who is admitted to a professional educational institute in that academic year (i.e. 2009-10 and 2010-11) and shall not be revised till the completion of his professional course in that college or institute. The fee structure so determined shall not be applicable to all the students on roll.
